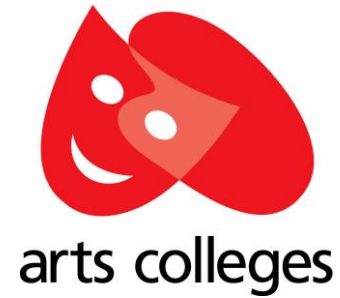

Dear Parent / Guardian,

ICT Residential Visit to PGL in Osmington Bay 2nd – 6th July 2012

As part of the ICT curriculum enrichment program we would like to offer the opportunity to year 8 students to gain first-hand experience of different ICT environments that are not easy to replicate in school.

Therefore it is my intention to take Year 8 students to Osmington Bay, a PGL run Activity Centre, in Dorset for the week from 2th to 6th July 2012.

The price for this week residential visit is **£390 per pupil**. This includes transport, accommodation, all meals and all activities (as per the itinerary attached) plus insurance. **A non refundable deposit of £40 will be needed by Tuesday 31 January 2012 to secure one of the limited places.** The remaining balance can be split over 2 further payments.

A second non-refundable payment of £175 to be paid by 27 March 2012
The final non-refundable payment of £175 to be paid by the 1 May 2012.

Of course you can pay in full any time before these dates.

There will be a briefing for parents and students and we will notify you of this date via the school website and a letter with the students who have secured their place.

There is also a document on the school website for details of the course.

If you would like your son / daughter to participate in this visit, **please return the £40 deposit** (cheques payable to Great Wyrley Performing Arts High School) **plus the attached medical consent forms** to Mrs Bakewell in the Finance Office **on or before Friday 31 January 2012.**

Sample Itinerary for Year 8 ICT Visit to PGL Osmington Bay 2nd July – 6th July 012

Osmington Bay - Located at the heart of the Dorset World Heritage coast, Osmington Bay comprises a 45 acre site with its own private beach. A popular centre for watersports as well as offering a comprehensive land-based activity programme, Osmington runs a range of Field Studies and modular ICT courses.

ICT modules are mixed with half-days of adventure activities.

- Recording sound and composing
- Data logging and analysis
- Theory and practice of animation
- Robotics design and control
- Plan, shoot and edit a short film
- Creating a multi-media presentation

Day 1: Arrival and orientation.

Day 2: Morning - Archery & Orienteering, Afternoon - ICT Study Unit: Control. Evening - 'The Great Egg Race'.

Day 3: Morning - ICT Study Unit: Forecasting. Afternoon - Fencing & Zip Wire. Evening - Talent Show

Day 4: Morning - Jacob's Ladder & Trapeze, Afternoon - ICT Study Unit: PGL TV, Evening - Disco

Day 5: Morning - Abseiling & Climbing, Return to school after lunch.
