Dear Parent

As you may recall, before the Christmas break I wrote to you outlining our thoughts and reasoning behind a review of the school uniform. I would like to thank those of you who responded to this letter and took the time to contact me with your views.

After careful consideration and feedback from yourselves, Governors, Staff and our own student council, we have decided to amend the uniform from **September 2010** as follows;

### Boys and Girls

School Sweatshirt or School Jumper, with School Badge (Maroon for Key Stage 3 / Black for Key Stage 4)

These are available from the Uniform Shop or in school.

**No other Sweatshirt, Jumper or cardigan will be allowed.**

White Shirt or Polo shirt	(Must be capable of buttoning to the neck)
Black / Dark Grey Trousers	(No jeans type or 'skinnies')
Black shoes with black laces	(No trainers. No logos or coloured laces)
Black Boots	(May be worn <b>under trousers</b> but must meet Health and Safety requirements. Ugg boots do not meet these requirements)

Hoodies, cardigans and scarves are **not** part of our uniform and **should not be worn**.

There will obviously be a 'change over period' for students but, as the uniform shop will no longer be selling the old uniform, all new clothes should meet with our requirements. Students entering Year 7 and Year 10 will be in the new uniform. Any Year 11 student opting to wear black will be required to wear the new school Sweatshirt or Jumper (no other black sweaters will be acceptable)

We would like to thank you in advance for your support and cooperation in enabling our students to look smart and adopt a business like approach to their studies. Students who fail to comply, without an acceptable explanation, will work in isolation or, where possible, be sent home to change.
